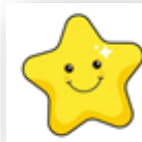

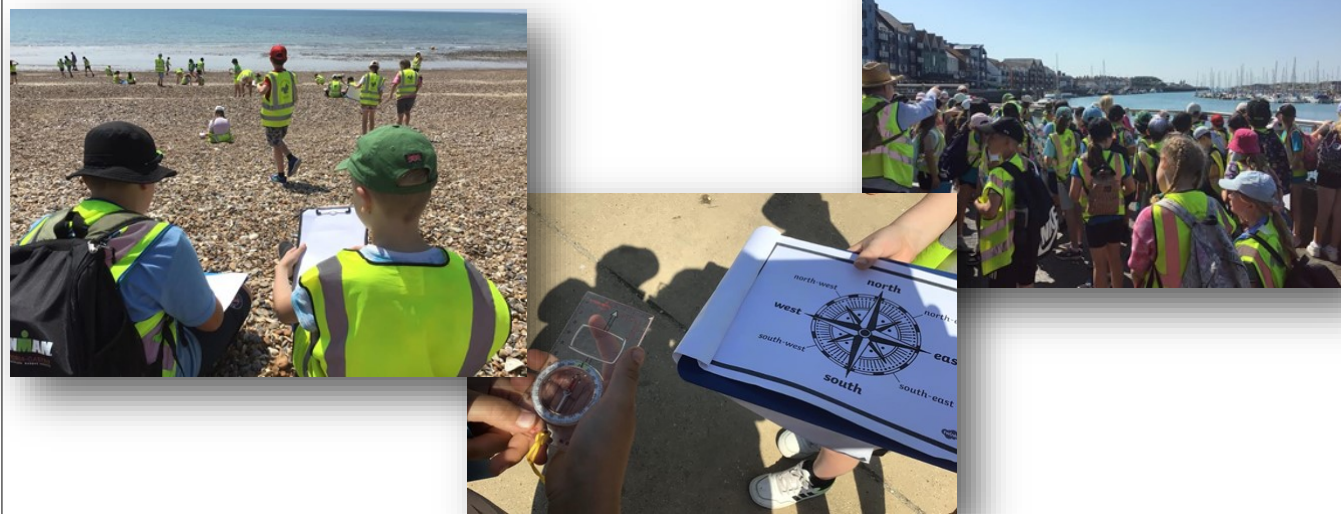

Year 5 Beach Trip:

As part of their topic and to participate in National Fieldwork fortnight, Year 5 visited Littlehampton beach and the Arun River. During the trip, they observed the red bridge, using their DT knowledge to identify the type of bridge it was and how it works. At the lifeboat station, Mr Pettitt gave us a talk about river safety and the work of the coast guard. Near the pier, they revised their recent work about the River Arun and its source, as well as looking at the river mouth where it joins the English Channel. They used a compass and identified human and physical features at each of the eight compass points near the river mouth. Finally, they created beach art.

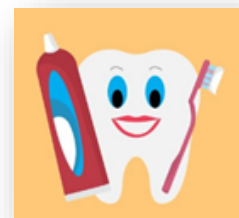


Free Dental Care:
