### **<u>RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO SAYERS CROFT</u> – Monday 5<sup>th</sup> December - Friday 9<sup>th</sup> December 2022**

Each year, the Year 6 children are offered the opportunity to go on a residential visit. It is with great excitement that we have managed to secure a booking at an extremely popular activity centre called 'Sayers Croft' near to Cranleigh in Surrey. The children will take part in a range of adventurous activities such as wall climbing, abseiling, ropes course, team games, orienteering alongside some ecological studies. All activities will be led by highly trained instructors and we will have a lead instructor to support us for our whole visit. There are centre staff on site 24 hours a day. Accommodation will be in chalet dorms with a common room and staff bedrooms in the same building. Each Class has their own annex and exclusive use of bathrooms. The building is fully lockable and secure and we will have sole use. There is a dining room where chefs will prepare a selection of delicious food for each meal, all of which is fully included in the cost.

#### The Cost of the visit, made up as shown below, will be £194.00 to cover;

- Food and accommodation £125.00 •
- Activities £47.00 •
- Administration cost £9.50
- Transport £12.50 •
- Insurance (covered by school)

The element of board and lodging are fully chargeable to parents. This charge will be £125.00 per child, which includes breakfast, lunch, dinner, drinks and snacks for the duration of the visit.

All other costs, as shown, will be £69.00 and parents are being asked to make a voluntary contribution of all or part of this amount. Parents are not obliged to make a contribution, but it is probable that, if insufficient monies are received, the visit will have to be cancelled.

We would like to confirm the number of children wishing to attend and ask for a **£44.00** nonrefundable deposit, to be paid by Friday 29th April 2022.









If there are exceptional cases of hardship, the school will try to support costs through its own budget, but this would reduce what we are able to spend in terms of materials and equipment for the children. If a family is in receipt of specific benefits, the school is obliged by law to waive the charges. (Please refer to the school's charging policy, which is on our school website or from the school office). If you wish to speak to me in confidence about the entitlement to waive charges, please do not hesitate to contact me to arrange an appointment.

If you wish your child to be included on the visit, please make payment through SchoolPing for **£44.00** no later than **Friday 29<sup>th</sup> April 2022** and complete the online consent form. The remaining cost can either be paid in 1 single payment or 5 instalments through SchoolPing, following the payment schedule below: -

Friday 24 <sup>th</sup> June 2022	- £30.00
Friday 29 <sup>th</sup> July 2022	- £30.00
Friday 30 <sup>th</sup> September 2022	- £30.00

If you are unable to use the online system, please contact the School Office direct and we will arrange for you to make payment either by cash or cheque, however, please note that the payment schedule may differ slightly from the one above

We will be holding an information evening in the autumn term, where we will have the chance to tell you more about the centre and the plan for the week. We shall also be sending out a form for medical details, special dietary requirements and emergency contact details nearer the time of the visit.

We will keep a close eye on any new Covid restrictions which may or may not come into force during the planning of this visit and will act accordingly.
