Snapshot of the week:

Year 6 went into the Nebula to represent how blood moves through the body. We used red and blue counters to represent oxygenated and deoxygenated blood, and showed how blood flows through the chambers of the heart, before going to the lungs and then other organs.



Year 6 made a model of the heart using a glass, water, a balloon and 2 straws. The straws were acting as the arteries, whilst the balloon acted as the heart wall. This investigation showed us how the heart pumps blood through the arteries.



Y1 have been exploring spirals during our art lessons. Today we used chalk to create a group piece of art.







Y5 wrote space raps inspired by the solar system. They then added percussion instruments to keep their rhythm and rehearsed them before performing them to the class.
