Important Reminders—please read:

Please ensure your children **stay on the path** with you when lining up in the morning and do not run over the grass areas. Please do not allow your child to go under the low hanging tree at the front of school.

Children are not allowed to play on the play equipment before or after school during drop off and pick up.

Please **park courteously** around the school, making sure that none of our neighbours are blocked in. and keep your speed low as there are lots of children walking to school. (Parents are not permitted to park in Woking court at the back of the school and may face a fine if they do so).

The children have been looking really smart since coming back to school and we remind you to continue sending them in wearing **black shoes**, no trainers please.

If children wish to have a snack at break it needs to be **fruit** please. A number of children have been eating parts of their lunch at breaktime so it may be worth asking if they need a little extra (fruit) for the morning. KS1 children are offered fruit in school.



Year 4 have had a magical start to the year. They have boarded the Hogwarts Express and headed off for the new term.










