Dear Families

Please find attached our latest OfSTED report following our inspection on 1<sup>st</sup> -2<sup>nd</sup> May. The school is currently judged as 'Requires Improvement' and the Governors and Senior Leaders believe that this is a fair reflection on where the school is at the current time.

'Requires Improvement' is a judgement that means the school has not yet met all of the 'Good' criteria in each OfSTED category. Inspectors recognised that our current School Improvement Plan identifies all of the areas that need to be developed and that safeguarding remains effective. We have attached a family version of the Improvement Plan, which identifies how we will work quickly to secure the changes that are recommended.

The Inspectors acknowledged that the school has 'experienced a period of leadership turbulence' since 2015. However, we are delighted that there is clear recognition of the positive changes that have been made since January this year.

We would encourage you to read the full report as the true character of Georgian Gardens is captured. For example "Pupil's welfare is at the heart of this caring school. Pupils who need a listening ear or have worries are supported effectively. This helps to ensure that everyone is included and happy at Georgian Gardens".

Other strengths included: increased rates of progress in reading, opportunities to develop a wide range of skills in art and sport, effective provision and leadership for pupils with Special Educational Needs, pupils are confident and self-assured and they are proud of their school. The good progress in Early Years was also recognised and this area remains with a good overall judgement.

We would like to thank all parents, staff and pupils who took part in the feedback to OfSTED. From this, the Inspectors were able to identify the 'high morale and optimism for the future'. We look forward to continuing to work with you to grow our school together.
