Fri 12th June new toys

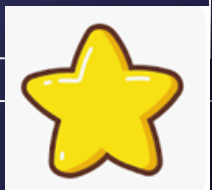

KS2 will begin at 1:15pm



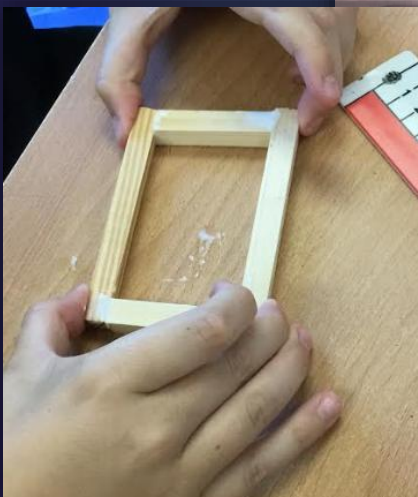
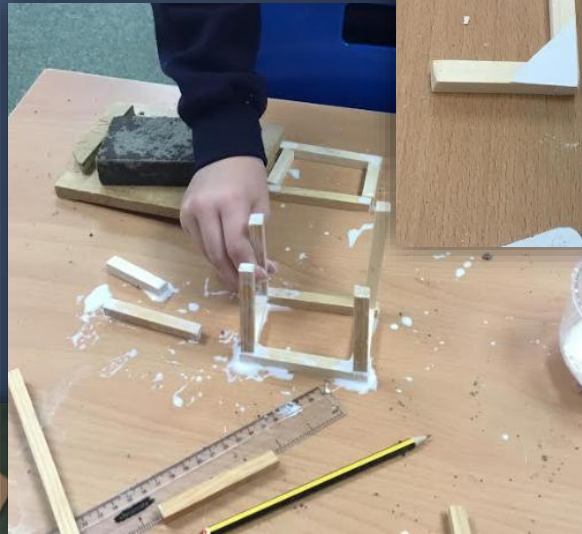
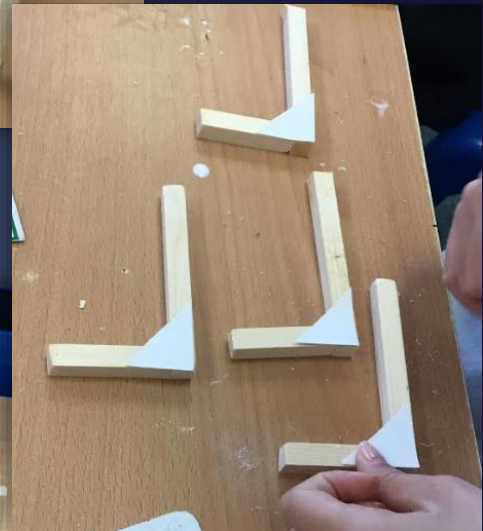
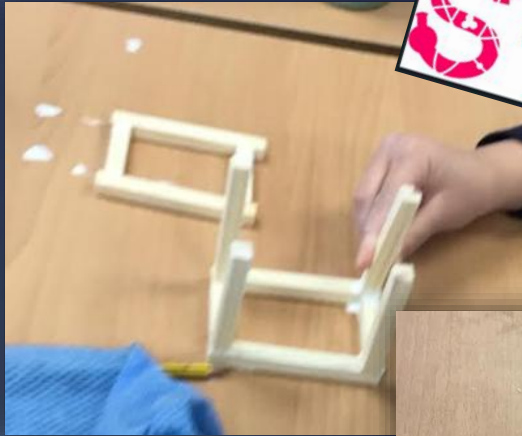
Our annual family picnic will be held on the field between 12 – 1pm
