Music at Georgian Gardens Primary School.

The National Curriculum for music aims to ensure that all children:

- Perform, listen to, review and evaluate music.
- Be taught to sing, create and compose music,
- Understand and explore how music is created, produced and communicated,

During their time at Georgian Gardens, every child will have the opportunity to sing in a performance. (YR R,1,2 Christmas Performance. Year 6 Musical).

All children will have the opportunity to attend extra- curricular music clubs; e.g Choir, or Samba band.

All children will have the opportunity to learn a musical instrument through the West Sussex Peripatetic music service and visiting teachers.

All children will attend a weekly singing assembly.

Knowledge

- I know that all music has a pulse or beat.
- I know that music is written with its own notation.

- I know that music is made from several interrelated dimensions; pitch, duration, dynamics, tempo, timbre, texture, structure.

Skills

- I will be able to compose and perform my own compositions both independently or as part of a group.
- I will be able to watch orchestral musicians, naming their instruments and identifying what family of instruments they come from.
- I will be able to conduct others and follow a conductor.

- I will be able to work within a team, either leading or following a conductor.
- I will be resilient when learning and practising a new skill.
