


Our wonderful school:

AS part of our filming day before half term, we had a drone operator take shots from above. Here is just a small sample which showcase our wonderful grounds and location.












Please note that unfortunately, there is no summer sport camp this year at school. Many other agencies run camps in the holidays so do keep an eye out for adverts in the coming weeks.
