Car Park

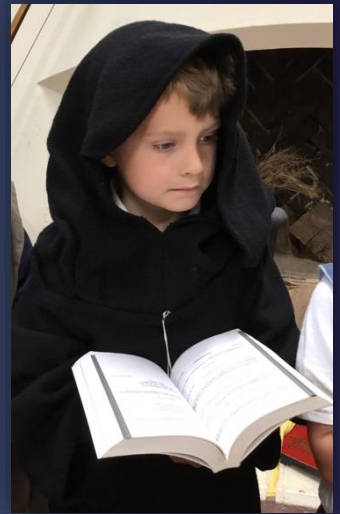
We have had some extremely close misses with children almost being knocked over in the car park.

Thankfully, one of our governors, Gemma Arkinstall, was keen to be a model for the dressing up activity!



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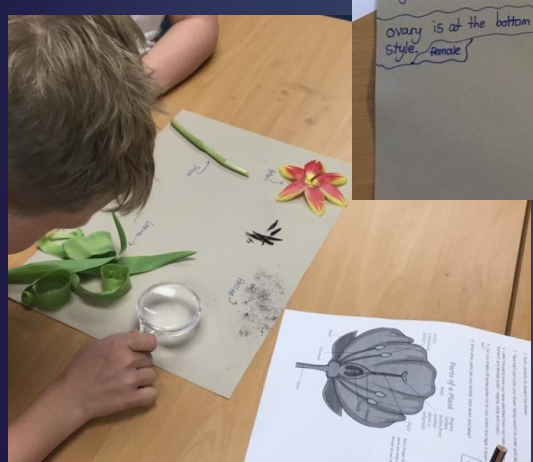
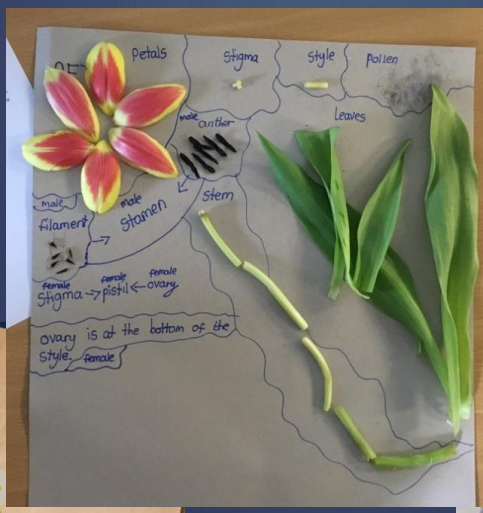
