### **We have a sporting superstar in our midst!**

Many of you may not know that Mr Alcorn (Y4 class teacher) plays water polo at an extremely high level. He was once awarded the title of 'most valuable player' by the British Water Polo Team in May 2020. He attended the 2012 Olympic Games in London as part of Team GB but spent the games on the subs bench. It is with great excitement that we can announce that he has been picked for the England team to play in a tournament this week-end. Ten years of anticipation, many more years of hard work to reach his goal. To us, he is not just representing his country but he is also representing GG and we are so very proud of him. On Wednesday, the whole school spread out around the playgrounds to give him a special GG send off to the competition. We can not wait to see him again on Monday to hear all about it.



Mr Alcorn will be playing in the water polo EU Nations Senior Mens Championships, held in **Brno, Czech Republic**. The competition runs from Thursday 25th until Sunday the 28th and consists of 12 teams. Slovakia, Belgium, Switzerland, Egypt, Austria, South Africa, Wales and the Czechs. We have been drawn in a tough group against the Lithuanian's and Ukrainians. They play twice on the Friday to decide places for the second round of groups and then play twice more on Saturday, before a final game on Sunday morning. A pretty tough schedule! There will be a live stream on You Tube – search for it on the competition days to keep an eye on how it is all going.

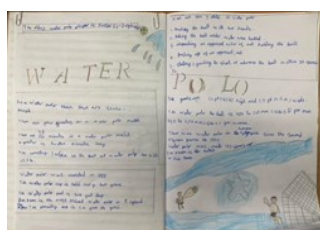

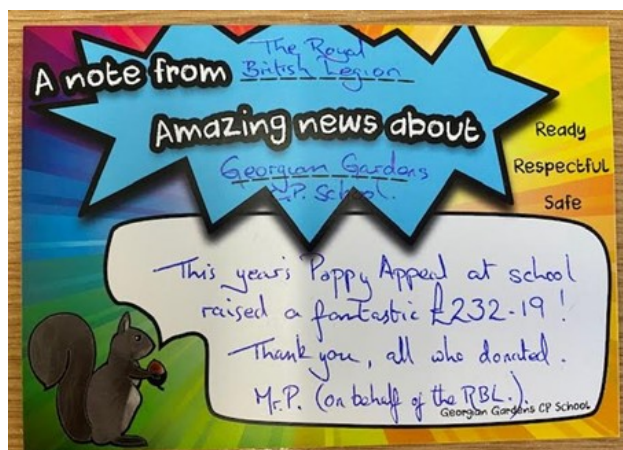
