From September 2026, school meals at Georgian Gardens will be provided by ISS Education, who are taking over from Chartwells as part of a new West Sussex County Council contract. ISS will be bringing exciting new menus and a brand new online ordering system to make managing school meals easier than ever for families.

Great news on price too, meals will be just £2.95 per day, which is 25p less than the current charge. Keep your family safe at home, beaches, rivers, and pools with Royal Life Saving Society resources for parents

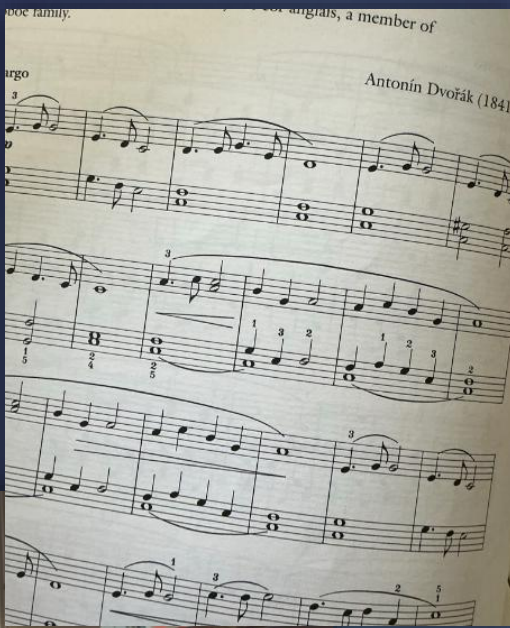
Check the weather, sea conditions and tide times before you travel

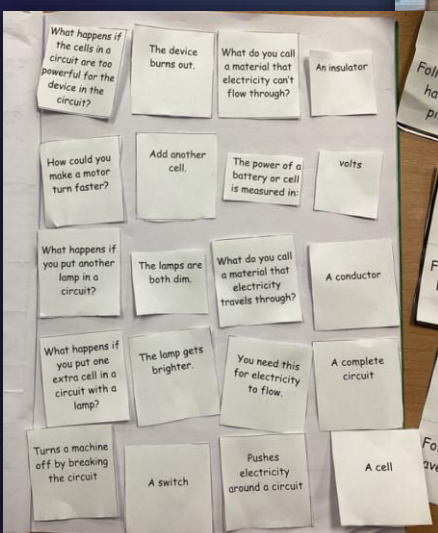
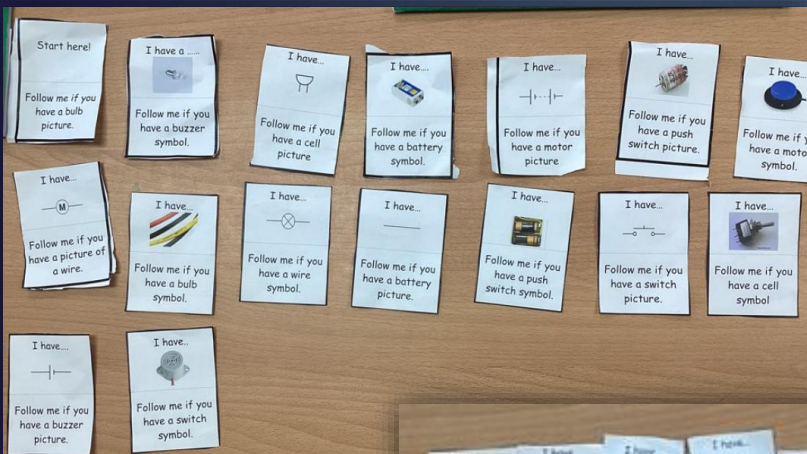

On Friday, Year 5 learned the melody from a beautiful piece by the Czech composer Antonín Dvořák. Each class practised and performed the melody on pianos, keyboards and glockenspiels, with some pupils adding the left-hand accompaniment. Pupils also explored the structure of a symphony and learned that Dvořák composed his *From the New World Symphony* during his visit to the United States in 1893, drawing inspiration from the music and culture he encountered there.



The Y6 children had to use their knowledge of electrical circuits and their symbols to complete a set of loop cards as well as matching up questions to pre-determined answers.
