Reminders:

- ⇒ We are still missing some data collection sheets—please do send them in by Monday so that we have up to date contact details.
- ⇒ Lateral flow tests are only meant to be used on children over 12 and only if there are no symptoms. Should your child show any symptoms of covid (cough, high temperature, loss of taste/smell) you will need to take them for a PCR test and they will need to isolate until a negative result comes through.
- ⇒ Please remember to fill in the flu vaccine permission form, details of how to access this was sent via Ping on 27th September. This needs to be completed, even if you do not give permission for your child to have the vaccine. The closing date for this is to be completed is Friday 15th October .
- ⇒ There is a small food bank available through school. Speak, in confidence, to Miss Lewry if this is something that would be of help to you.
