The Three Ps:

In assembly on Monday all of the children had a fascinating talk from two representatives from Southern Water. There has been a real issue with local drains lately and so they are visiting schools and working with households to work on preventative measures. We heard about all of the items often flushed down the toilet which should not be there. They explained that the way to remember what can go in the toilet is 'The Three Ps' - **pee, poo** and (toilet) **paper**. A bonus 'p' is **puke**. The children were shown shocking pictures of drains blocked with wipes, nappies and cotton buds. Your child will have brought home a 'gunk pot' to put fat in after cooking (to solidify then throw away), some bamboo face cloths to wash and re-use instead of face wipes and a sink strainer to prevent food chunks from going down the sink along with some leaflets.

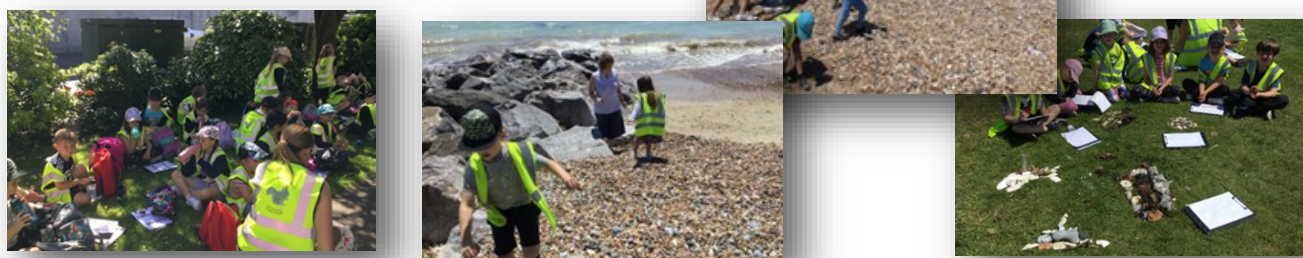
Forest School Day:

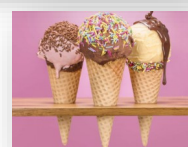
Year 1:
