The items of food that we need on a regular basis are: cereals, UHT semi-skimmed milk, pasta, rice, pasta sauce, tuna, tinned pies, tinned tomatoes, tinned fruit, tea bags, coffee, squash and baked beans.

Visit as a family, meet our Headteacher and Early Years team.


Open Events— Wednesday 18th October @ 1:30pm Tuesday 14th November @ 9.30pm and Tuesday, 14th November @ 6pm
