Rationale for Learning

This term we will focus settling the children into school, making friends and learning initial letter sounds.

Suggested activities for families to help support learning

Read regularly to your child.

Revise letter sounds as they come home – from week 4.

Hear your child read their school books.

Go on a teddy bears picnic.

Practice writing, saying and looking for focus sounds (phonics).

Look for numbers when you are out and about.

Visit the library.

Look for signs of autumn when you are out.

Key Vocabulary: Phoneme, diagraph, phonics, sound, letter.

Shapes- square, rectangle, circle, triangle, hexagon, quadrilateral, 2D.

Positional language- under, over, behind, next to, though, in front, on, off, inside, outside.

Topic words – doctor, nurse, paramedic, dentist, head teacher, caretaker, firefighter.
