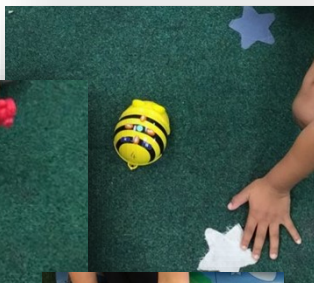
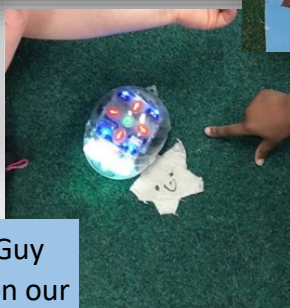
The child with 100% attendance in this last week, chosen by a random generator:

Parking—forward notice:

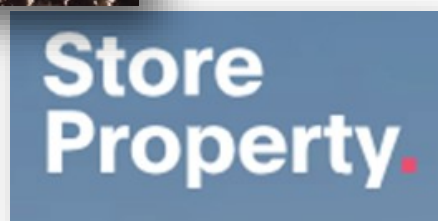
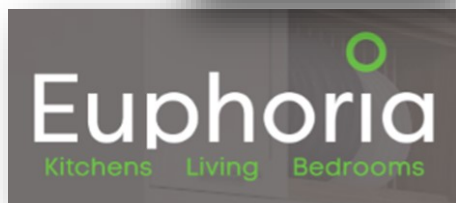
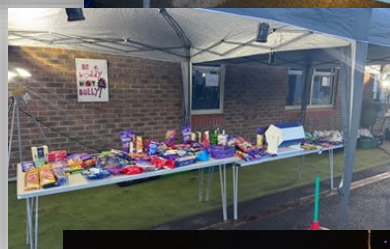
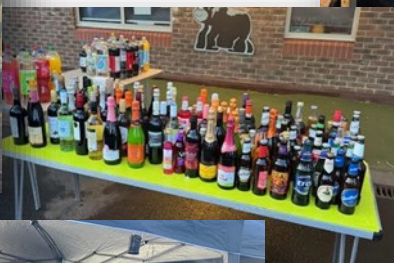
