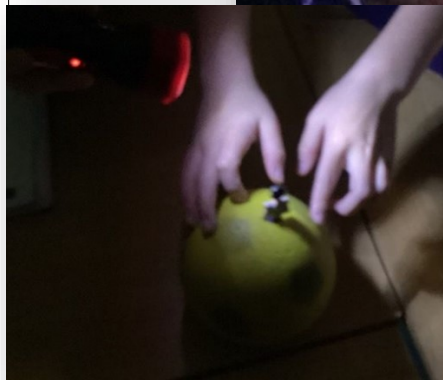
The class with the highest attendance in the past week:

Y5 investigated how light travels and how shadows are formed. We then explored how day and night are created and how the movement of shadows is caused by the rotation of the Earth on its axis.

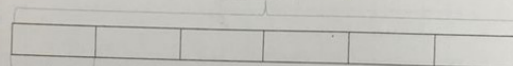
