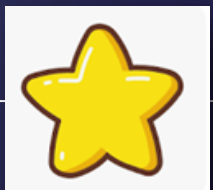

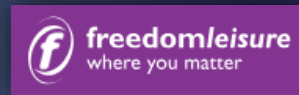

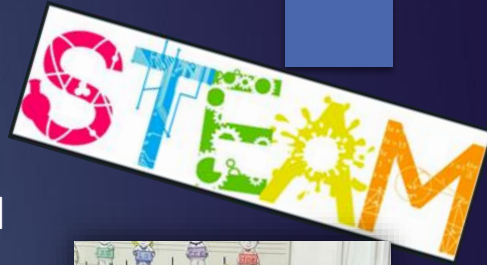
The children were treated to a visit from a selection of birds on Thursday. What a super experience!
