## Weekly Updates

## Dear Families,

Congratulations to our Year 6 pupils who have been out and about completing their Bikeability training this week. This is an important opportunity for them to learn about how to ride safely and increase their own road awareness. In assembly this week we all thought about the importance of road safety and how to look after ourselves when we cross the road. As the weather continues to improve it could be a great time to start the whole family walking to school together, if you live close enough to do so.



Year 1 have also been out and about today, we hope they had a great time learning more about their local area.













Two of our Georgian gardens children, Stanley and Elsie wanted to make sure everyone at school had access to a defibrillator in case of an emergency situation. The children decided to raise money to fund a defibrillator, So the family set them challenges to raise the money during lockdown including 30 day exercises, tennis drills/splits practice etc. "We never expected to be able to raise the whole lot, but when we couldn't get funding, it just went from there, we were thinking of ways we could try and get the last bit, then the coffee and biscuits happened" The children put coffee and biscuits in each of the staffrooms in school in return for donations. The children have raised an incredible amount of £975 which will be used to buy a defibrillator. A massive well done from all at Georgian Gardens.

### Toys in school

We have noticed that several children have started to bring toys into school. We ask that children do not bring in toys (including fiddle toys) unless this is due to a sensory need as agreed with Mrs Lewis our SENDCo.

We will keep you updated with any new developments as we hear them. We are hoping that we will be able to host some of the events on a smaller scale than normal and should be able to provide more information about this soon. We are beginning to organise some school trips now and have also been able to welcome our brilliant volunteers back into school.
