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Snapshot of the week:

As part of their DT project Year 3 have been designing their own cushions and learning two new sewing techniques. The children all learnt how to sew a cross stitch and the appliqué technique. We also had lots of practise threading needles!! We combined this topic with Maths where we measured our pieces of fabric and the length of the thread they wanted to use. Soms children measured their gaps between their stitches. All the children completed their cushions and took them home. We are very proud of them.

Word limit: 300 words maximum.


Closing date: 9th May (extended date) All entries need to be to Mrs Thomas by Friday 2nd May.
